



Fines & Fees - Senior

All regular overdue items

(except those listed below)

- 20 cents/day per item
- \$5 per item maximum

DVD & video games

- 50 cents/day per item
- \$5 per item maximum

EXPRESS collection

- Book: \$1/day per item
- \$20 per item maximum

- DVD: \$2/day per item
- \$20 per item maximum

- eReader & iPad mini: \$5/day per item
- \$30 per item maximum

eReader

- eReader replacement cost: \$200
- lost or damaged USB power cable: \$6
- lost or damaged soft carrier pouch: \$15
- fine for deleted content: \$2/book
- late charge: \$5/day (\$30 maximum)

iPad mini

- iPad mini replacement cost: \$400
- lost or damaged USB power cable: \$6
- lost or damaged soft carrier pouch: \$38
- late charge: \$5/day (\$30 maximum)

Chromebook/MacBook – in-library use only

- Chromebook replacement or damage cost: \$400
- MacBook replacement or damage cost: \$1,600

Interlibrary loan

- 75 cents/day per item
- \$10 per item maximum

Book club kit

- \$1/day per kit
- \$10 per kit maximum

Other charges

- Lost or damaged library card: \$2

Borrow, Renew, Return

- Most items have a 21-day loan period.
- An item usually can be renewed if no one is waiting for it.
- Return items to any BPL location.
- All branches (except Kilbride) have a 24-hour drop box for returns. eReaders must be returned to a check-out desk.
- A daily fine is charged when items are overdue and returned late.
- Fees are charged for lost or damaged library items.
- When you owe \$35 or more, your account is sent to a collection agency and charged a \$15 administration fee.
- Payments, including program fees, may be made in cash, by debit, or by cheque payable to Burlington Public Library.
