What Can You Build?

- A house
- Bakery or restaurant
- Library or school
- Tree house or park
- Car or bus

Material Ideas

- Small boxes (cereal, frozen food, tissue)
- Egg cartons
- Scrap paper magazines
- Cardboard packaging

Guidelines:

- The structure should not be larger than a cereal box
- Use mostly recycled materials
- If needed, use tape, glue, or staples to assemble your structure
- The structure should stand on its own
- Write your name on the bottom of your structure
